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**Katy Athersuch** is the Innovation and Access Adviser for Médecins Sans Frontières's (MSF) Access Campaign based in Geneva, Switzerland. Before joining MSF in 2009, she was the Coordinator of the Stop AIDS Campaign in the UK, a coalition of over 80 UK based NGOs working on HIV and International Development. Katy is currently completing a MSc in Global Health Policy with the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine having previously studied International Relations and Development Studies at the University of Sussex. In 2014 she spent 6 weeks working with MSF in Liberia as part of the ebola response. Her interest is in overcoming barriers to the lack of innovation for diseases that primarily affect people in developing countries and ensuring affordable access to these important health technologies.



**Dr. James Cleary** is the Associate Professor of Medicine in University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health. He is an international leader in Palliative Medicine and is a board member and past president of the American Academy of Hospice and Palliative Medicine. Currently he is the director of the Pain and Policy Studies Group of WHO Collaborating Center for Pain Policy in Palliative Care, and a commissioner in the Harvard Global Equity Initiative - Lancet Commission on Global Access to Pain Control and Palliative Care.



**Shiva Raj Mishra** is an Australia Awards Scholar in University of Western Australia and member of Nepal Development Society. He is extensively involved on the fund raising for relief and reconstruction activities of NEDS in the aftermath of Nepal's recent Earthquake. He is part of editorial team in BMC Public Health, and also a member of the Lancet Youth Commission in Essential Medicine Policies.



**Sam Wing Sum Li** is a medical student in the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He has internship experience in the headquarters of World Health Organization and the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East. He is an initiator and member of the Lancet Youth Commission in Essential Medicine Policies. Recently he served in the Steering Group with UN MGCY for the Doha Global Youth Consultation.
